

Foreign Fellowship Grant of KES (Korean Endocrine Society)

Korean Endocrine Society offers a financial support program for physicians who have commitment as a visiting scholar in the field of endocrinology at a teaching hospital or institution within South Korea, and whose visit is sponsored by a member of KES.

Eligibility for Application

In order to apply for this Fellowship Grant Program, candidates must fulfill requirements stated below.

- Applicants should have a good understanding, both in writing and speaking, of either Korean or English. Those whose first language is not English must have adequate Korean or English skills.
- Applicants must be a clinical fellow in endocrinology department or endocrinologist who has clinical experience of more than 2 years
- Applicants should be currently employed at a non-profit hospital.
- Applicants should be approved as a visiting scholar at a teaching hospital / institution in Korea.
- Applicants' ages should be preferentially under 35 years old.
- The annual average income of applicants' residing countries should be low, such that their gross national income (GNI) per capita for the previous year (based on the latest data of World Bank) is less than \$6000.

Range of Support

- The role of Korean Endocrine Society in this program is limited to financial support only.
- This program supports about one million Korean won (KRW) (about \$ 890 USD) per month during the visiting period upto 6 months.
- Applicants should execute VISA processing if necessary through the visiting hospital /

institution. KES does not sponsor VISA processing for applicants.

Required Documents

Application form, Curriculum Vitae including publication list,

A copy of current employment certification, and a copy of Passport, Photo (3x4 cm),

Letter of recommendation (should be from professor in endocrinology field)

A copy of permission (certificate) for a visiting scholar (from Korean teaching Hospital/Institution),

Project statement

Required Documents should be completed and sent to KES office by e-mail or by mail, no later than 3 months before the initiation of the committed visiting program.
